# The FairTax How It Works

The FairTax replaces our "Income Tax" system with a tax on "Spending"

Actually, a tax on spending was the only "Legal" means of taxation set forth in our Constitution by our Founding Fathers. Only through deception did our politicians in 1913 make "Income Taxes" legal through the 16<sup>th</sup> Amendment to the Constitution. Look on your paycheck stub at the Federal taxes, Social Security, and Medicare taxes taken out of your paycheck,

In todays "Income Tax" system, 22% of the cost of American made products are taxes embedded in that cost. When the FairTax goes into effect, most all of this 22 cents in every dollar will go away. The FairTax replaces these "income based" taxes with a retail sales tax on new goods and services at the rate of 23 cents of every dollar. The tax will already be included in the price on the shelf and your receipt will show how much of that price was taxes.

There will be **NO TAX** on used goods whatsoever.

We will go from 160 million income tax payers to over 350 million sales tax payers, including the criminal underground economy and the 50 million tourists who visit our country each year.
