## **CAN WE AFFORD A PARTY?**

Have you ever considered the differences between the current Income Tax Code and the Fair Tax? Consider the simple action of buying food for a party. (Budget of \$100.00)

It can be a child's birthday, football tailgate or any other event. (It also applies to any purchase you make.) You decide, but here is the affect the taxing system would have.

Note: The self employed business person has reduced his revenues by 26% to eliminate the embedded income taxes on his fees for services! The party event is for purchases for personal use not part of the business.
